The gallery features juried original art by local and regional artists in a broad range of media. Gallery sale commissions help provide funds for educational programs, scholarship, and art classes.

In addition, the gallery has an outreach program to provide exhibit space for local art groups and student exhibits.

Education

Classes are offered quarterly in all areas of the visual arts. Special classes are offered in the summer for children. Youth scholarships are often provided to reduce class fees.

Presentations and slide programs are featured throughout the year by artists, educators and experts to expand public awareness and interest in the visual arts.

Jury Criteria

1. Creativity – Originality

- Is the design original and a fresh approach to its type of media?
- Does it show a creative talent?
- Has the artwork been completed recently?

2. Aesthetic Expression

- Is the artwork appealing to the eye?
- Upon initial viewing, does the viewer want to study it in more detail?
- Does the artwork make a statement?

3. Composition

- Does the composition gracefully lead the eye to the key object in the artwork?
- Do different parts of the artwork compete for the attention of the viewer's eye?

4. Technical Competence

- Is the artwork of good quality?
- Does the artwork indicate the artist has good technical skills in the medium?

5. Overall Appearance

- Is the 2-D artwork framed properly?
- Does the matting and framing compliment the artwork?
- Is the presentation clean, without signs of wear?
- Does the artwork have impact?

6. Jury Process

- There will be an interview with Center representatives to ascertain the artist's interest and abilities in staffing the gallery and meeting their contractual obligations.

Participating Artist Membership

- An Artist wishing to become a member of the Art Center of Estes Park may join as a Participating Artist.
- Artists must be juried before membership is accepted.
- Artists, if accepted, pay an annual fee of \$100.00.
- Artists will also select one of the membership options listed below:
 1. Staff the Art Center a minimum of 12 full days or 24 half days a year and serve on one committee.
 2. Staff the Art Center twenty full days with no committee obligations
 3. Pay a fee of \$650 annually in lieu of staffing 12 days with no committee obligation.
 4. Pay a fee of \$325 annually and staff the gallery 6 days or 42 hours per year between May 15 and November 1 with no committee obligation.
- The Art Center will charge a 40% commission fee on all art sold.
- **Jury dates for 2020:**

Dec 30, 2019	June 8, 2020
February 17, 2020	August 11, 2020
March 16, 2020	September 22, 2020
April 27, 2020	November 3, 2020
- Only original works of art will be accepted for jury.
- All 2-D artwork must be framed and appropriately backed. Sawtooth hangers are discouraged. Hanging wire must be attached securely. Pieces in Duraplaq format must have hanging wire attached.
- Watercolors must be under glass or Plexiglas or archival preservation medium.
- Each additional medium requires an additional 3-5 pieces.
- Art work may be submitted by mail or in person.
- Notification of acceptance or rejection of art will be sent within ten (10) working days after jury of art.

Please submit with the following:

1. A minimum of three (3) and not more than five (5) original works of the same medium.
 - Title of the art works
 - Medium of the Artworks
 - Size of each art work
 - Completion date
 - Retail price
2. A current resume and/or biography about your art including a list of awards and special recognition.
3. Any publication and/or press releases you feel would assist in the review process.
4. Current exhibit venues.
