## Tangled Ribbons with Annie Reiser

## **Materials List:**

- Sketchbook or notebook for taking notes and practicing tangles
- Black and Brown Sakura Micron pens 01
- 3 soft graphite pencils B to 3B Very important to have as these we will be creating the ribbons with these.
- tortillion (paper blending stump)
- kneaded eraser (optional as I have some to share)
- gold and white gel pens (I will share white pens)
- colored pencils: I used Prismacolor Sienna Brown, Terra Cotta, and Henna but any artist-grade colors in similar hues will work.
- White charcoal pencil
- Colorless solvent blender from Prismacolor or Copic

## Otherwise, you may purchase a kit directly from the instructor for \$8.00 on the day of class which will include everything you'll need including:

1 black 01Micron pen, 1 brown 01 Micron pen, gold Gelly Roll marker, General's white charcoal pencil, soft graphite pencil, tortillion, Tangle Tags, and piece of chocolate.
