## **Enchanted Tangled Forest** with Annie Reiser

## **Materials List**

If you do not purchase the kit, you will need, tan tile – either a Zentangle® Renaissance tile or similar. My sample shows trees drawn on:

- tan toned 4x4-inch **Strathmore Artist Tiles**.
- red permanent marker I use Sakura Micron pens 01 or 03,
- white gel pen I like Art 'N Fly and Signo Uniball, but Gelly roll works too.
- white charcoal pencil- I use General's-, tortillion (paper blending stump).
- Even if you purchase the kit, you will need artist-grade colored pencils: light red, dark red or burgundy, light brown, dark brown, and white. I used Faber Castell bistre, 179; Faber Castell nougat, 178; Prismacolor raspberry, 1030; Prismacolor black cherry, 1078; Prismacolor white, 938
- Sketchbook or notebook for taking notes and practicing tangles is always good to have but optional.

\*Otherwise, you may purchase a kit directly from the instructor for \$5.00 on the day of class which will include everything you'll need including: a few Zentangle® tiles, red Micron pen 03, white gel pen, white charcoal pencil, tortillion, Tangle Tags, and piece of chocolate.

\*Note: Teacher will have the following items available for everyone attending the class: kneaded erasers, and colorless solvent blender to share,

colored pencils to share but if you want your own, see materials list.
