Materials List

- Sketchbook/journal with quality mixed media paper (a nice size is approximately 9x6 inches. The journal should be coptic-bound meaning it opens flat. Spiral-bound works well too.
- Watercolor paint and or watercolor pencils
- Fillable water brush or travel watercolor brush
- Graphite pencil - HB or B to 3B range
- Fine permanent marker (I use Micron pens by Sakura – size 01 is best for our purpose)
- Camping chair, stadium cushion, or a jacket to sit on
- Large rubber band to keep journal pages secure if windy
- Bottled water
- Sack lunch (optional)
- Ruler

A Mini Field Art Kit is available for purchase directly from instructor, for \$35 on the day of class, if you wish. But please make note of several items on this list to bring along that are not included in the field kit, should you choose to purchase one.

The Mini Field Art Kit contains:

A quality multimedia sketchbook from Holbein, small tin containing palette and watercolor paint. Fillable water brush, micron pen 01 from Sakura, pencil, blending stump, special rubber band to hold pages in place when windy, red acetate square, paper towels or soft cloth (100% payable to teacher day of instruction).
